



Job Description: Extended Care Worker

Responsible to: Elementary Principal

Purpose

Serve as the adult childcare provider of students enrolled in BBA's before and/or after school child care program; responsible for the welfare, health and safety of multiple children in a controlled environment

Skills and Qualifications (both physical and professional)

- Spiritual maturity to understand and to handle the struggles that may be involved in childcare
- Genuine love for and concern for the spiritual welfare of students
- Strong desire to work in a fundamental Baptist church and school ministry
- Personal motivation, self-management, and detail-oriented
- Exceptional communication abilities especially with fellow staff and with parents
- Great ability to control and motivate students in an extended care program
- Must have a spirit of cooperation and complete loyalty to the administration and pastoral staff
- Well prepared for the challenges and excitement of the day
- Ability to stand long periods of time and walk up to ¼ mile at a time
- Ability to climb stairs repeatedly throughout the day
- Ability to raise arms over your head for an extended period of time
- Ability to lift 30 pounds
- Overall good physical and mental condition
- Applicants must meet all applicable NC State guidelines regarding medication and conduct as stated in the NC Child Care Handbook

- Enforce established policies and procedures to maintain control
- Supervise and balance the downtime and the study time
- Understand and implement NC Child Care Requirements
- Learn by name and face the parents of the students
- Monitor campus movement

- Attend all school programs and show support of our athletic and Fine Arts programs
- Attend all regularly scheduled BBC services and show support to a specific ministry
